



7.1.2 MANAGEMENT OF THE VARIOUS TYPES OF DEGRADABLE AND NONDEGRADABLE WASTE

As per the policy documents, following system for degradable and non-degradable waste is implemented in college campus:

Solid waste management: As a part of green campus initiative students are given awareness to maintain pollution free environment by conducting environmental awareness programmes. Faculty advises the students not to litter and unwanted materials inside the campus. For solid wastes separate garbage bins are kept for segregation of bio degradable and non-degradable wastes. Bio degradable wastes are dumped in a composting pit where vermi-composting is done which is later taken as manure and used for gardening. At our college NSS, Swatch Bharat and ECO Club jointly take up initiatives to maintain the environment clean.

Liquid Waste Management: Through proper drainage system liquid waste water are disposed from canteen, toilets. Through underground drainage system, all laboratories hazardous liquid wastes are safely disposed.

E-waste management: E-waste such as discarded computers, printers and broken laboratory equipment are safely stored in allotted room to be suitably disposed.



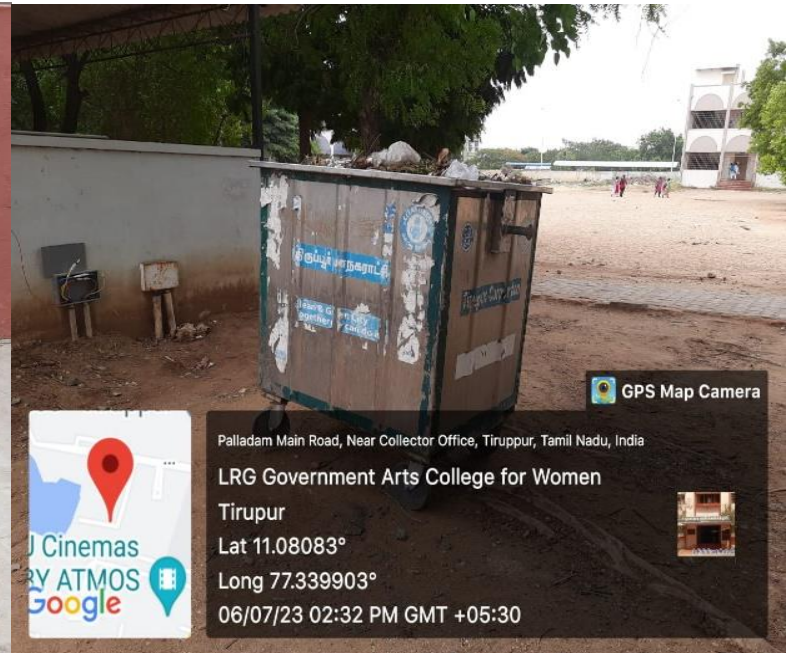
