



7.1.2 Water Conservation

Provision is made for rain water harvesting at the college building. This prevents water clogging and wastage of water during excessive rain fall. During summer water shortage can be met with. Bore well is also dug to meet the requirements of water for labs and wash rooms. Storage tanks are constructed to cater to the needs of water for labs, wash rooms, canteen etc.

Rain water obtained from the roof of buildings and inns, the water collected is diverted to a deep pit. Harvested water used primarily for the purpose of recharging ground water to overcome the loss of groundwater. Three feet in diameter and twelve feet in length were shaped like structures and rainwater was stored in the pits.

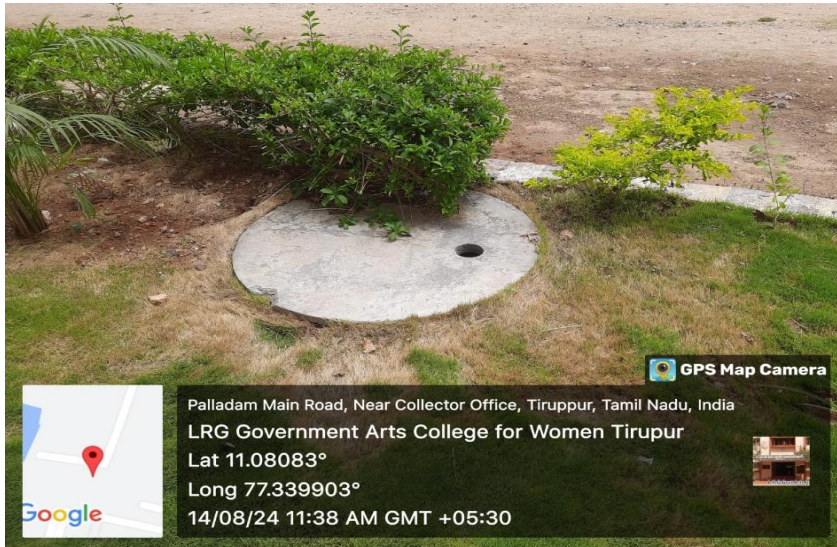


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Rain water harvesting Pits at campus
