The student feedback is important to strengthen the quality of teaching-learning environment and to search for opportunities to improve overall institute performances.

The overall feedback report given above is in terms of students rating a particular parameter. Most of the students were satisfied with the various aspects of the courses and the teaching-learning experiences, with the few students being moderately satisfied.

Most of the students are highly satisfied with the Principal, faculty members and the college office with regard to various parameters such as administration and the ability to motivate students.

The feedback has given to the performance of office is highly commendable. Regarding library and laboratories of science departments the feedback is very encouraging.

On additional facilities, the students opined that there is a scope for improvement in the internet facility, canteen and washrooms provided by the college.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS AND SUGGESTIONS:**

- The library is complexly digitized. So it is accessible 24\*7 to the students. Besides the collection of textbooks, reference books and magazines of the Library could be enhanced further.
- Smart classrooms for better understanding.
- A digital notice board in the college campus would help students in updating themselves on the day to day activities of the college.
- Clean washrooms are necessary for girls' students.
- Free Wi-Fi and better gym facility are essential too, for the physical and intellectual growth of the students.

## **FEEDBACK ANALYSIS FROM ALUMNI**

### **SUGGESTIONS:**

- The alumni have strongly suggested organizing Industry-specific workshops and seminars to equip the students with the skills and knowledge demanded by the employers.
- These workshops cover topics such as Resume writing interview techniques group discussions and on other demands of the industry.
- Alumni recommended concentrating on Industry mentorship programs to connect students with experienced professionals in their fields.
- This would allow students to gain valuable insights into the Industry and guidance on career development.
- The alumni strongly believe that involving students in the path of innovation and entrepreneurship into its curriculum to encourage students to think creatively and develop their entrepreneurial skills.

### **ACTION TAKEN:**

Workshops, Industrial Visits, Seminars and Internships were arranged for students, Activity-based learning is implemented everywhere.

## **FEEDBACK ANALYSIS FROM FACULTY**

**(FOR THE YEARS FROM 2018 – 2019 TO 2022-2023)**

Individual courses are designed to address the outcomes of the programs and the vision of its various departments.

Special care has been taken to design each course module and the outcomes based on Bloom's Taxonomy.

Faculty members are recommended to organize value-added programs to enrich the employability skills and to focus on specific industry requirements time to time.

Many faculty members have suggested to have the learning infrastructure facilities such as laboratory requirements, Library and purchase procedure.

Field-oriented and research focus projects, Case studies and assignments need to be provided within the course for internal evaluation.

In programming-related courses, the staff has suggested more interaction opportunities with the industry and modification of the course content as per the industry requirement.

In PG level, there is a need to increase the opportunity for conducting the research and project-related activities.

In general, the system of evaluation is good with regard to the model and end semester examination. However, the continuous assessment system should be more structure with different assessment tools to assess the skills and application-oriented understanding of the students. A more comprehensive rubric based on the assessment needs must be adopted along with the current tools. This would help to differentiate the students based on their learning competencies.

## **FEEDBACK ANALYSIS FROM EMPLOYER**

**(FOR THE YEARS FROM 2018 – 2019 TO 2022-2023)**

In general the feedback received from the employers has been favorable, expressing contentment with the graduates hired from the Institution.

A significant proportion of the employers were of the opinion that the Institution has provided quality education. Nevertheless, a few employers are of the opinion that the curriculum should be more pragmatic and Industry- centric to equip the graduates with the necessary skills for the workplace.

The graduates have been certified to possess' commendable technical skills and subject matter expertise. However, a few employers perceive that the graduates were deficient in practical experience, soft skills, problem solving, critical thinking and adaptability to various situations. Employers opine that there was scope for advancement concerning teamwork, leadership and conflict resolution.

The majority of employers have reported on being fully satisfied with the graduates recruited from the Institution. A small number of employers have suggested that students pursue multi-disciplinary skills in order to enhance their career growth opportunities.

Based on the recommendations made by the employers, the members of IQAC and Board of Studies would have to incorporate more of Industry-Oriented and value – based courses into the curriculum. CRT Programs need to be organized in the campus to the problem-solving skills, leadership qualities, management skills, communication skills and other interpersonal skills of the students.

## **FEEDBACK ANALYSIS FROM PARENTS**

**(FOR THE YEARS FROM 2018 – 2019 TO 2022-2023)**

Parents have entrusted the future of their children in the hands of the Institution. Hence their feedback plays a very important role in the development and enhancement of the quality of Education.

Feedback from parents allows the Institute to evaluate its service provision and to provide excellent service towards the student community.

The above graphs show that 82% of the parents have found the infrastructure of the college is good. 90% of the parents have felt that the college is safe and secure for their children. 92% of them have said the college is a good place for their children to have learning experience. 90% of the parents have acknowledged that academic skills and knowledge of the faculty members are good. 85 % of the parents are satisfied with the fests, events and extra-curricular activities. 75% of parents have suggested that the assessment about the placement and internship opportunities needed improvements.

### **ANALYSIS AND OUTCOME**

Parents are satisfied with the good infrastructure of the college and they have found it to be safe and secure. They have also found that the children have a good learning experience in the college as a result of the knowledgeable staff, teaching their children.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS AND SUGGESTIONS:**

- Parents have suggested that there could be more resources provided in the Library and Laboratories.
- They have also felt that the placement and Internship Opportunities by the College needed improvement.
- In the suggestions given, it was evident that most parents have felt the need of career counseling for students in the college.
- On analyzing the feedback received over the course of time by the parents, it is observed that parents are highly satisfied by the efforts made by the college administration in admission, teaching and learning, discipline and other activities.

- High degree of satisfaction has been shown by the parents on the implementation of the suggestions made by them.



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
